

5 Facts to Know About: Pentecostalism

- 1. Pentecostalism is a Protestant Christian denomination that was born out of the charismatic, evangelical revival movements of the late 19th century. It was organized in early 20th century and is now one of the fastest growing denominations in the world with approximately 13.7 million adherents in the United States and 279 million worldwide.
- 2. There is no central governing body for Pentecostalism, but many churches belong to the Pentecostal World Fellowship.
- 3. Pentecostalism embraces the idea of spiritual baptism, which can manifest itself in speaking in tongues and divine healing.
- 4. There is a great amount of variety within Pentecostalism due to questions over the trinity vs one-ness of God and whether focusing on divine healing means modern medicine should be rejected or embraced.
- 5. Famous American Pentecostals include Oral Roberts, Megan Fox, Denzel Washington, Marvin Gaye, Al Green, and John Ashcroft.
